DO HEREBY RESOLVE: DECIDE, PAR LES PRESENTES: To approve a By-Law to be known as By-Law No. 10 which supercedes By-Laws Nos. 3, 4 & 5 and details Traffic Regulations for St. Regis Reserve No. 15 and Cornwall Island Reserve No. 59.

- "Council" means the Council of the Iroquois of St. Regis Band of Indians; and In this By-Law (a)
 - "Reserve" means the Akwesasne St. Regis Indian Reserve. (b)
 - That these regulations apply to all roads, streets, lanes or other places (c) open to the public for the passage of vehicles.
- No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 30 Thirty miles an hour within the Reserve.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 of this by-law no vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 20 twenty miles an hour within any school zone in the Reserve designated and marked as such by the Council, and no vehicle may pass a school bus when stopped.
- "Vehicles" means any wagon, cart, motor-car, motor-truck, trailer, motor-cycle, traction engine, tractor, road-making machinery or other conveyance that is driven, propelled or drawn by any kind of power.
- 5. The driver of any vehicle shall bring such vehicle to a full stop when ordered by an Indian Constable or an R.C.M.P. Constable authorized by the Akwesasne Indian Band Council to enforce these regulations, and shall obey all directions issued by such authorized person in respect of the routing or control of traffic, including the parking of whicles.
- No vehicle in a dangerous or unsafe condition shall be operated on any road within the Reserve of Akwesasne (St. Regis).
- No vehicle may be parked on any road, street, lane or other place open to the Public Passage at all time.

DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

DECIDE, PAR LES PRESENTES:

- Respecting Bus Transportation of Children:
 - (a) When a motor vehicle being driven on any part of the Akwesasne St. Regis Indian Reserve overtakes or meets an autobus engaged in the transportation of children, which is stationary to take on or discharge children, whether such autobus is proceeding in the same direction as the motor vehicle or not, the driver of such motor vehicle shall come to a full stop at least ten feet from the rear or front of such autobus, and shall not pass or drive beyond any part of such autobus, until all children have boarded the autobus or have left it and reached the side of the road and such autobus has again been out into motion.
 - (b) Anyone who contravenes any provision of this Section 8(a) shall be liable on summary conviction
 - to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offence; (a)

 - (b) to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the second offence; (c) to a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and to imprisonment for thirty days for a third subsequent offence.
- 9. That any unregistered vehicle or the vehicle driven by an unlicensed driver be seized until such time as legal proof is produced for lawful operation of such vehicles, that the vehicle will be towed away at the owner's expense and that a fine of \$25.00 twenty-five dollars will be levied for this offence.
- Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law with exception of Section 8 & 9, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
